The Birth of the Bab is one of the Twin Holy Birthdays that celebrate the birth of two central figures of the Bahá’í Faith on November 1st and 2nd in 2016. Anne Alleva, CCIU Co-Chair, is a music teacher at the CREC Ana Grace Academy of the Arts Elementary School and has directed the CT Baha’i Chorale. Terry Robinson is the CCIU Treasurer and a P&W engineer. The local Baha’i community, which meets in the homes of its member, does not have a local house of worship. The event will take place in the sanctuary of Unitarian Universalist Society: East, which is not affiliated with the Baha’i Faith. DIRECTIONS:

Unitarian Universalist Society: East, Manchester, CT:

From points west: Take Route 84 East to Exit 63. Turn LEFT onto Route 30/83-North. At the second traffic light, turn RIGHT onto Taylor Street. Stay on Taylor Street until you reach the second stop sign. Turn RIGHT onto West Vernon Street. UUS: E is 0.25 miles on the LEFT. **From points east:** Take Route 84 West to Exit 63. Turn RIGHT onto Route 30-North and go over the bridge. At the fourth traffic light, turn RIGHT onto Taylor Street. Follow directions above. **From Willimantic and Storrs:** Take Route 6 or 44 where Route 384 begins. Take the first exit (back onto Route 6/44-West). Go 2 miles. At the third traffic light, turn RIGHT onto Vernon Street. Go 1.5 miles. Turn LEFT onto Vernon Street West. UUS: E is 0.5 miles on the RIGHT.
