Bidding

You can simply scroll through the auction website to see all of the listings. There is also a preview of the Live Auction items that will be available at Sunday's live event. You can click on a category (listed on the right) to see just the items in that category. Clicking on the Mr. Chili logo brings you back to the home page.



Items that have bidding show a gavel in the corner. There are also fixed price items (like dinners, classes and activities) that are available on a first-come, first-served basis at a per person set price.

The silent auction closes at midnight on Saturday, June 12. Check back on your items often so you're not outbid!

Creating an Account

You will need to create an account on the site. Here's how. *These instructions are also available on the site.*

Registering for Your Account

1. Click on "[My Account](#)" in the menu bar

2. Enter a username and your email address
 - **Note:** This username *will* be displayed for any bids you make. If you wish to remain anonymous, please consider a non-identifying username.
3. Then click "**Register**"
 - You will be automatically logged into your new account
 - An email will be sent with your account password in it to the email address you provided
4. Once logged in, click on "billing address"
5. Click "Add"
6. Fill out the form with your name and billing address details
7. Click the button at the bottom to save
7. Click on "Account Details"
8. Make sure to update your name and display name to your liking
9. Click "**Save Changes**"

If you created an account during the holiday fair, you can use it again. You would have created an account if you bid on the fair's silent auction items. If you only made purchases, creating an account was optional.

Payment

There are two options: you may pay using your credit card on the website OR we can email and invoice and you can send a check to the UUS:E Office.

Cancelled Events from Last Year's Auction

Cancelled events will not be rescheduled. If you bought a meal or activity that couldn't take place due to COVID-19, you will receive a credit equal to half of what you spent on those purchases. You can use that credit on your 2021 auction invoice, regardless of what you buy this year. You should be receiving a credit statement by email by May 30 at the latest. 103 Rock Climbing

Ready to try rock climbing? Do it safely (as possible) with a rope and experienced guide.
